

# 2009 Indian Nation FCF Totem Quilt



- The Totem Quilt is being made and then awarded as a fund raiser for the Indian Nation Chapter FCF. The quilt will be hand made and, when finished, will measure approximately 7 ½' wide and 9' long.
- There will be one hundred sixteen 9" quilt squares available for purchase by FCF members. The one hundred sixteen square will be equally divided between Young Bucks and Old-Timers. The four center squares are being reserved to include the FCF symbol and year on the quilt.
- Each square will have one persons personal FCF totem embroidered on it, along with their FCF name below their totem in standard text.
- Each square is being sold for \$10.00 for each square.
- The squares will be sold as a 'first come-first served' basis. There are a limited number of squares available, so get your order in early.
- To purchase a square, you must fill out a Totem Quilt Square order form for each square you wish to purchase and mail a copy, along with \$10.00 for each square purchased, to the address provided.
- The last possible date to purchase a quilt square is February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009. This is to allow the quilt maker enough time to finish the quilt in time for the drawing.
- The box on the order form is for you to draw your totem in. How you draw your totem on the form is exactly how it will be embroidered on your square. The quilt maker will be using tracing paper to copy how you've drawn your totem onto the square you've purchased. Your totem must stay inside the box, but draw it as large as possible, using as much of the box as possible. The totem will be embroidered on the outline only, no fill will be embroidered in your totem on the quilt square. Every effort will be made to make your totem appear exactly as you have drawn it.
- There is a page on the Indian Nation FCF web site dedicated to the Totem Quilt. Once your Totem Quilt Square order form and monies are received, your name will be added to the list on the web site, showing your square is reserved and will be included on the quilt. Your square will not be guaranteed until both your order form and monies are received. Make checks payable to Don Paige.
- The quilt will be awarded during the Saturday evening service at the 2009 Oklahoma district Pow-Wow. The exact way the quilt will be awarded is still being considered by the district office.
- A book will be included with the quilt, containing a copy of each quilt square order form. This will give the winner of the quilt a key to the quilt and allow them to reference exactly whom each totem belongs to.

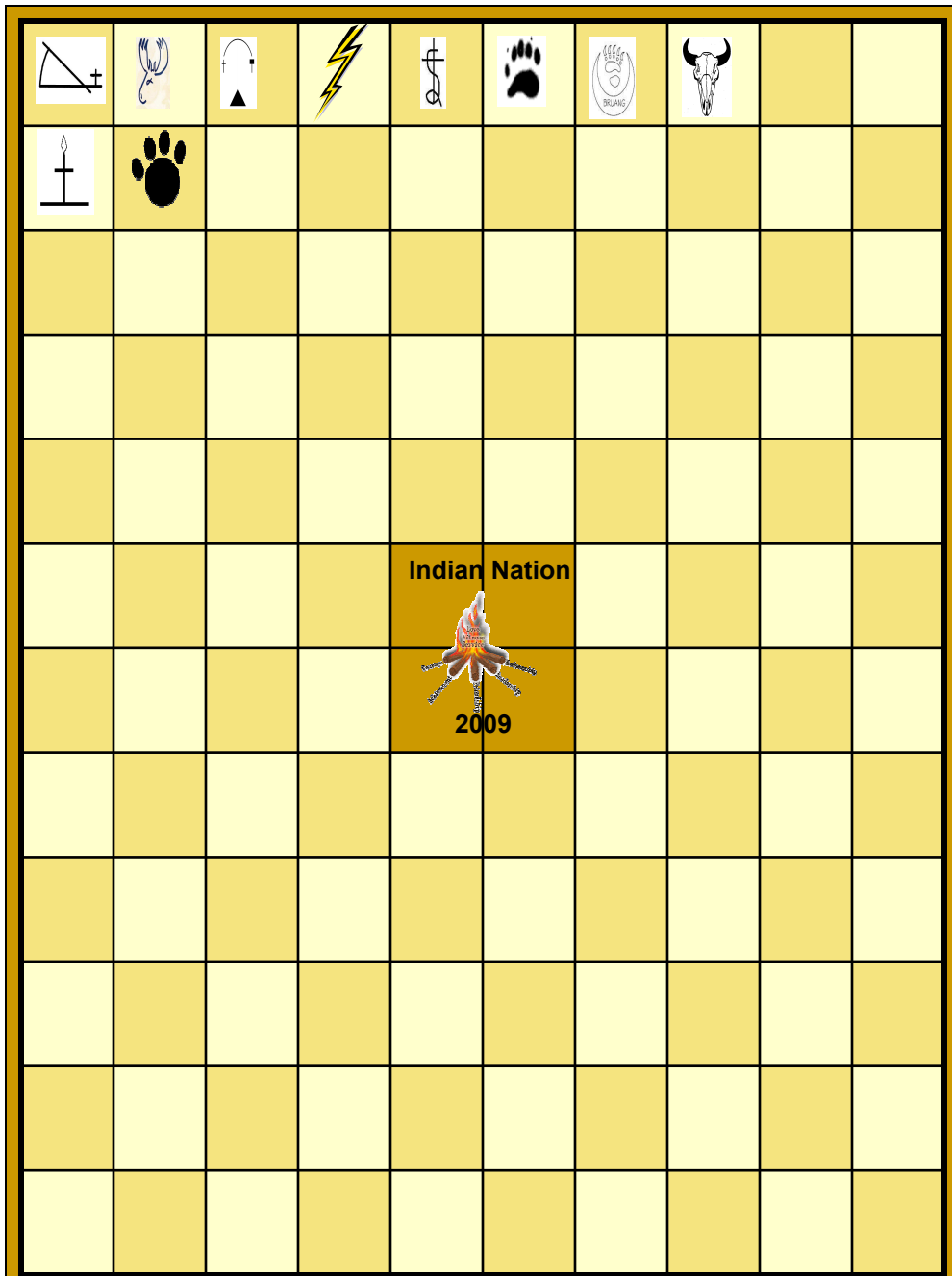

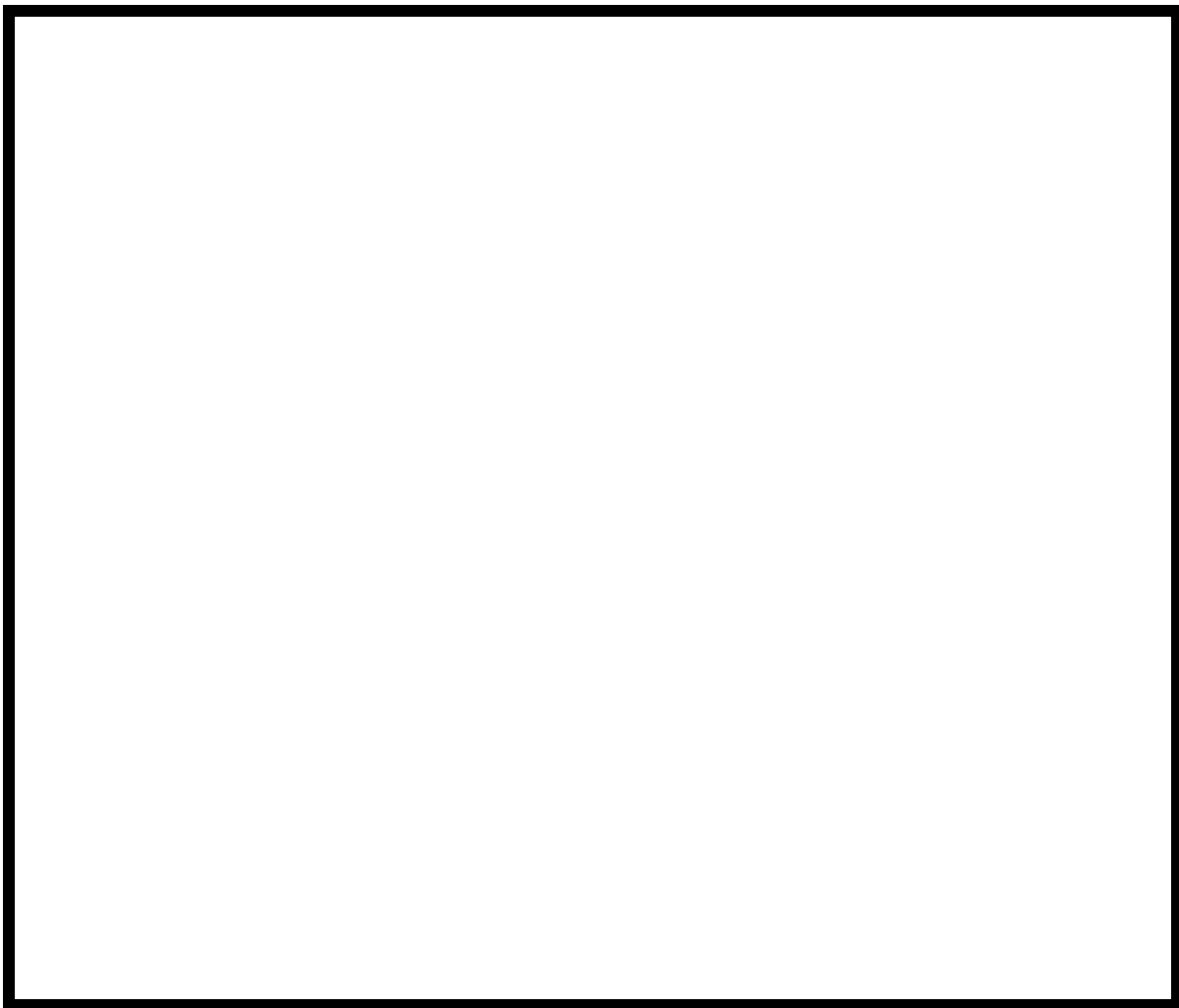
